

WHAT CAN PINK LADY® DO FOR YOU TODAY?

Thanks to this Do-It-Yourself activity, offer shelter to bats, our winged allies who fight against insect pests!





List of materials required:

- 3 boards: Back panel 40x23x1 cm Front panel 30x23x1 cm Roof 27x7x1,5 cm
- 2 battens (30 cm long and 2 cm thick)
- 4 wooden strips
- · A measuring tape, ruler and pencil
- · Wood screws, 5-6 cm long
- Screwdriver or drill
- · 2 screw hooks





Screw the battens to both 40 cm edges of the back panel.





Cut out the wooden strips and screw them to the panel, between the battens. The bats will use them to hang from.





Close the structure using the front panel (30x23x1 cm).



Attach the roof (bats will enter the box from the bottom, so it does not need to be removable).





Install the two hooks on the back of your nest box and hang it from a tree.

Pink Lady® tip

To make sure the bats are comfortable, use untreated and – if possible – rough wood so that the future tenants may hang from it more easily.
